HUMANITARIAN NEEDS

SHELTER, WINTERISATION and MULTI PURPOSE CASH needs are top priorities amongst displaced communities (REACH rapid assessment) with 50,000 households in need of tents or emergency shelter

UN CROSS BORDER AID




As of 17 Feb 2023, 178 trucks loaded with aid provided by six UN agencies have crossed to north-west Syria since the earthquakes

Highest number of deaths reported in:
1. Harim District (2507)
2. Afrin District (1107)

70% of all reported injuries are in Harim district
