Intake: John Compton Dam, Millet, Varnard, Ravine Poisson

Hill 20
Access blocked. Intake silted. Transmission line damage.
Intake: Marquis, Talvern, La Sorciere, Joseph

Forestiere
Access blocked, intake silted, pumps damaged

Au Leon
Access blocked. Intake silted. Transmission line damage.

Anse La Raye
Access blocked. Transmission line damage.

Thomazo
Access blocked. Intake silted. Transmission line damage. Damage to distribution network.

Bexon
No tap water, stand pipes available for those with damaged pipes.

Derniere Riviere
Access blocked. Intake silted. Transmission line damage. Reservoir compromised, can operate but will need eventual replacement.

Anse La Verdue
Operational

Canaries
Access blocked. Intake silted. Potential other damage.

Lombard
Access blocked. Intake silted. Transmission line damage.
Intake: Patience

Fond St. Jacques
Access to community and intakes blocked. Some transmission line damage. Power out.

Micoud
Access blocked. Intake silted. Transmission line damage.

Soufriere
All 4 intakes clogged and silted.

Delcer
Access blocked. Intake silted. Transmission line damage.

Operational

Access blocked. Intake silted. Transmission line damage.

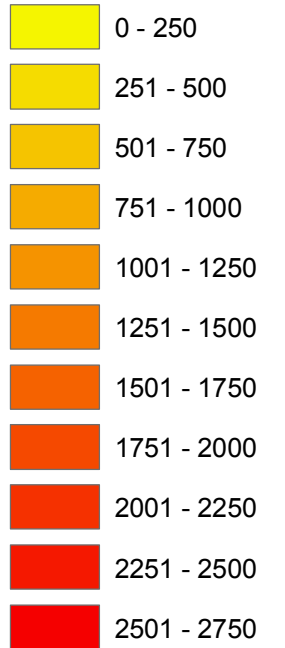

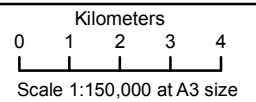
