

- Water trucking, hygiene kits, latrines, hand pumps distributed and installed.
- 10,500 Shelter and NFI kits (IOM) being distributed. UNHCR distributed 4000 NFI and 4000 plastic sheets.

Known Planned Assistance

- Further airdrops of High Energy Biscuits planned.
- Plan to establish satellite health hub in Kashmore.
- Addressing shortage of water trucks.
