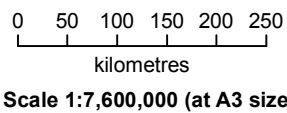


Three joint missions with UN and other agencies in **Burkina Faso, Niger and Mauritania** (started 10 Feb 2011)
