

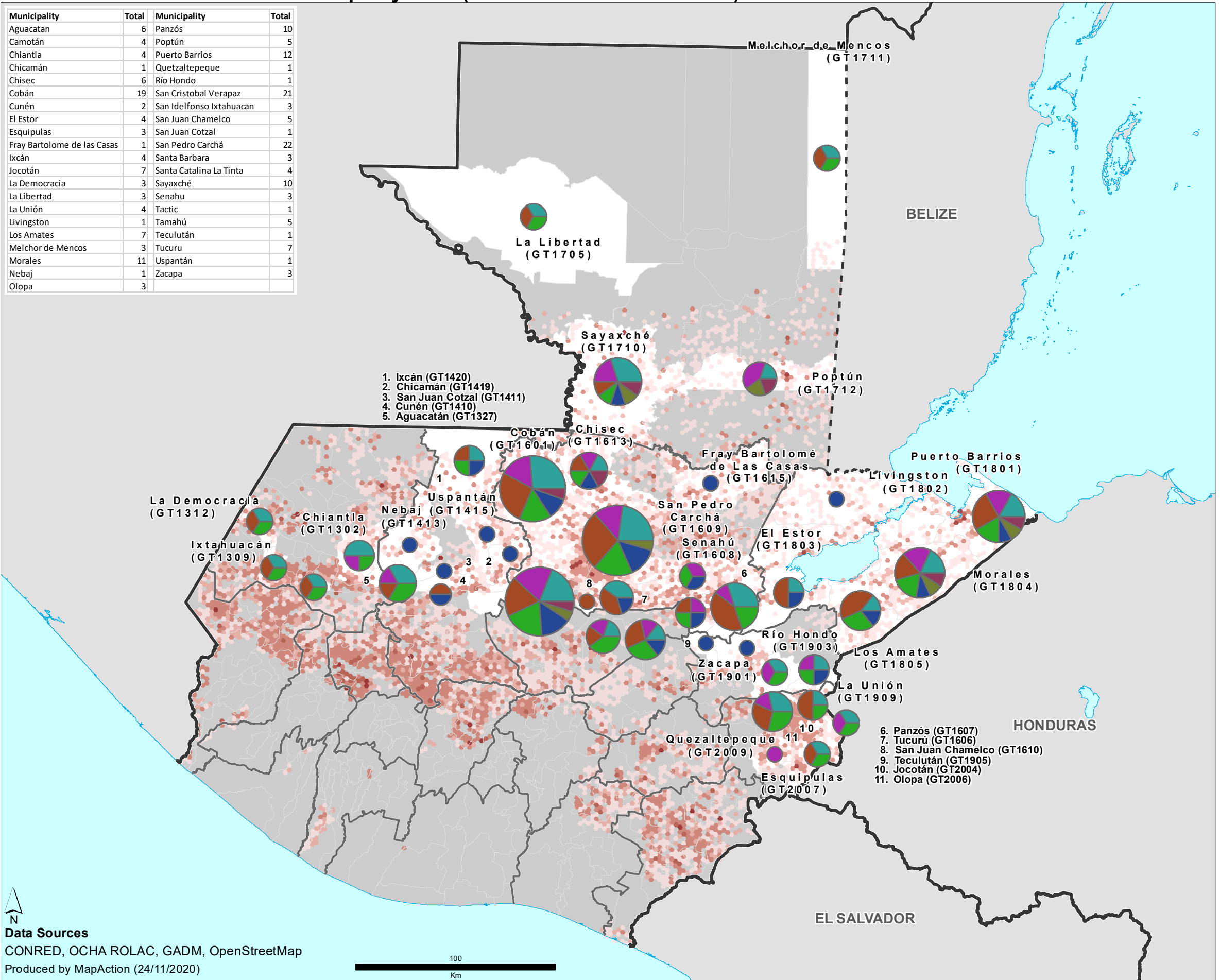
# Guatemala: Hurricane Eta / Iota
